



Preschool 3's Offerings

Program A - is held in our larger Preschool 3's classroom. You may choose 3, 4, or 5 days a week, full day or half day. You may pick the days that work best for your schedule. (Days must be consistent throughout the year). You have the flexibility of adding days as the year goes on, depending on space. You may also switch from half days to full days as your child's stamina grows.

Program B- is held in our smaller Preschool 3's classroom, and is a three day program, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays. You may choose half days or full days, and may switch from half day to full days as your child's stamina grows.

Thematic units that incorporate all content areas and multi-sensory fun **ELA:** uppercase and lowercase letter recognition, sound recognition, writing letters, first and last name writing **Mathematics:** number identification and number writing with the use of songs and rhymes., 1-1 correspondence of objects to the quantity of 12, rote counting to 20, **Introduction to scientific thinking:** wondering and asking questions, testing a hypothesis through experimentation

Curriculum Goals

ELA: Introduction of pre-reading skills, focuses more heavily on the phonemic piece of literacy, rather than identification and recognition, emphasis on lowercase letters, blending of sounds that create small words, and understanding how vowels help connect sounds together while blending words.

Writing Workshop: A scaffolding process beginning with writing basic sight words, progressing onto completing small writing passages. Mathematics: Achieving mastery of number identification, quantity recognition, 1-1 correspondence, introduction to addition and subtraction skills, problem solving, and pre-algebra concepts.

S.T.E.M. (Science Technology Engineering Mathematics)

Continuation of scientific thinking with an emphasis on experiments, observing changes, recording and understanding those changes, as well as introducing the Scientific Method.

Why TK?

We often call Transitional Kindergarten, "The Gift of Another Year." While many of our TK students have birthdays late in the year, that is just one of the reasons parents choose TK.

- A year of TK allows additional time for children to become more developmentally, socially, academically, and emotionally ready for their Kindergarten experience.
- The extra time allows children to gain more independence and mastery of preschool skills leading to greater confidence.
- Students are exposed to pre-reading skills as well as the concept of more individualized tasks vs. group work.
 "Seat work" is more structured and objectives are more clearly stated.
- The integration of TK into the larger school community through the specials they attend, eating lunch in the Hall, and participating in greater school events prepares students for a larger school experience.

Preschool TK Offerings

Our TK Program is a five day program, Monday - Friday. You may choose half or full days, and may switch from half to full days as your child's stamina grows.
